What is big data?

The term big data' points the fact that in our digital age, by using every day technologies, we generate loads of data that are collected in large databases with the goal of using them for current or future purposes. Even if you are not aware of it, you are a' subject of big data' in the sense that you are producing data that can be used to produce knowledge. This knowledge has an indirect or direct effect on how decisions are made, e.g. distribution of goods, prevention of diseases, traffic regulation, risk management, innovation of services, etc.

Is big data a big brother?
